SPECIAL NOTES:

After starting the class, students who drop out of the course will be responsible for the cost.

Additionally, any student registered for an AP class will be expected to take the corresponding AP test to receive the GPA weight and transcript designation.

Class Weights:

Dual-enrollment or Advanced Placement classes carry an extra 1 point. All Virtual Virginia courses listed as AP, carry this extra point weight.



Virtual Virginia

Virginia Virtual Advanced Placement School provides a variety of college-level and foreign language courses using distance learning technologies. It was designed to provide educational opportunities to schools that may have too few students to justify hiring a full-time teacher, are unable to find qualified teachers, or for students with scheduling conflicts. Advanced placement courses follow the College Board curriculum. Foreign language courses are open to students from the seventh grade and higher.

Scheduling Flexibility

Virtual AP School courses are offered on a full-year or 4x4 block schedule. Individual classes can be scheduled at any time during the school day. For example, two students can take AP Biology during first period and a third student can be scheduled during fourth period.

Individual Attention

Individual attention is emphasized in all courses and instruction is personalized as much as possible. Online teachers are available to students via telephone, e-mail, and fax for consultations and one-on-one instruction.

Comprehensive

Distance learning instructors are responsible for the total education of students from the initial class introduction to the final exam. Local schools must have a facilitator on hand to proctor tests, ensure students are on task, and forward information to the instructor. Facilitators need not be certified teachers.
