

KINDERGARTEN – all classes

- 4 boxes of crayons, 24 count
 - 2 packs WASHABLE broad line markers, basic colors
 - 12 glue sticks (NO glue bottles please!)
 - 8 sharpened pencils
 - 6 fine point black dry erase markers
 - 2 orange plastic pocket folders without prongs
 - 1 box of tissues
 - 1 pair blunt end scissors, Fiskars brand is strongly recommended
 - 1 backpack big enough to fit a full sized folder, snack, etc.
 - 1 vinyl covered rest mat (NO towels, blankets, or sleeping bags)
 - 1 container disinfectant wipes
 - Boys Only – 1 box Hefy One Zip Gallon Storage Bags
 - Girls Only – 1 box Hefty One Zip Quart Storage Bags

FIRST GRADE – Mrs. Conley's Class

- 12 pack of #2 pencils (plain)
 - 1 pocket folder
 - 2 boxes of tissues
 - 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
 - 1 yellow highlighter
 - 3 large erasers
 - 1 composition book
 - 8 small glue sticks
 - 2 packs of 24 count crayons

FIRST GRADE – Miss McMahon’s Class

- 2 boxes of 24 count crayons
 - 8 count box of washable markers (basic colors)
 - 12 count box of colored pencils (Crayola brand only)
 - 6 regular sized glue sticks
 - 2 boxes of tissues
 - 10 to 12 #2 pencils with erases (for homework – keep at home)
 - 1 fat eraser
 - 1 **small** pencil box
 - 1 composition book (any color) (This is NOT a spiral notebook)
 - 1 folder (2 pockets inside)
 - 1 package of wipes (any kind)
 - 1 box of baggies (quart sized for girls & gallon sized for boys)

FIRST GRADE – Mrs. Snyder’s Class

FIFTH GRADE

How Many?	Item
2	Boxes of tissues
Lots	Wide-ruled notebook paper (for binders)
Lots	#2 pencils with erasers
1 box	Colored pencils and / or markers
2	Glue sticks
1	Pair of scissors (There are some available in the classroom, but students may want to have their own pair)
1	Sturdy (either vinyl or poly; no paper folders please) homework folder / take-home folder.
1	Zippered pencil case (no boxes please)
3	Highlighters (yellow, pink, and orange please)
1	Container of Clorox or Lysol wipes
