

What if my child is sick and can't come to school?

Please contact the office and notify the school your child will be absent. Please remember for your child to be excused you must send a note to school with your child when he/she returns to school. You may email us at stanley@pagecounty.k12.va.us

What if I have concerns about something my child has told me has happened at school?

If you have any concerns about anything that is going on at school, please feel free to contact the office. We strive to make learning a positive experience for your child. Therefore, we appreciate your input with any problems your child might be encountering during the school day.

What if my child is having problems with another child on the bus?

If your child is having an issue with another child on the bus, please bring it to the bus driver's attention to see if the situation can be resolved. If there continues to be a problem, please contact the school office and we will determine what steps need to be taken to resolve the issue.

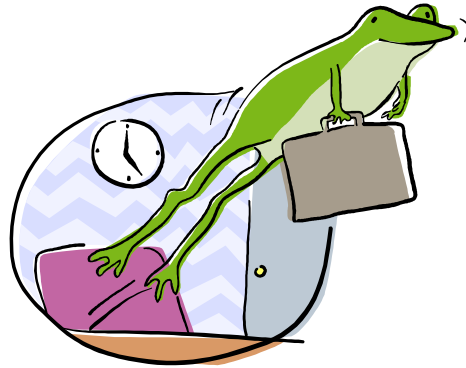
What if my child is having a difficult time dealing with either a school situation or a family situation that may be affecting his/her performance at school?

What if there is early dismissal for bad weather?

You may park in any unnumbered spot in the lot. Do not park in any numbered spot. Then come into the office for assistance.

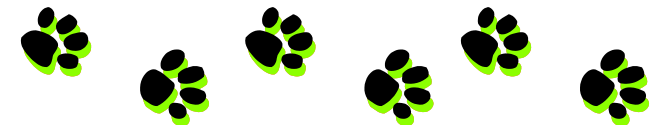

Frequently Asked Questions

What time should I drop off my child?

Students should not arrive prior to 7:45 a.m., as supervision is not available at that time. Home-room begins at 8:00 a.m. and classroom instruction begins at 8:15 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 8:15 a.m.

Where do I drop off my child? Students are to be dropped off at the lower parking lot. Please do not block the driveway or gates, as this is the only access for emergency vehicles to enter the school.

What time should I pick my child up?

Dismissal time is 3:15 p.m. Students will be dismissed from the back gym door area.

Where do I park when I pick up my child after school?

Students are to be picked up in the lower parking lot. You may park in any un-numbered spot in the lower parking area.

What if I need someone to pick up my child?

Send a note to school. If the school does not receive a note, the person sent to pick up your child will not be allowed to take your child out of school.

What if my child needs to ride a different bus than usual after school?

Send a note to the school. Please indicate the date, bus number and driver of the bus your child is to ride. Your child will be given a “bus pass” to give to the bus driver with the designated stop.

Reminder: It is against Virginia State law to pass a school bus when loading or unloading students.

What if my child is going home with another student?

When one student is going home with another, both students must have a note verifying this from his/her parent. If riding a bus, please indicate the date, bus number and driver of the bus your child is to ride.

What if my child needs medication at school?

If a student needs medication on a daily basis throughout the year, or for a short term situation, the parent must fill out a medication form and leave the medication with the school nurse. You must follow all county procedures.

What if my child gets sick at school?

In the event your child becomes ill or is injured at school, the school nurse will contact the parent listed on the student’s “Permission For Emergency Care” form. Every parent should supply the school with the name and number of at least one other person who can be called if the parent cannot be contacted. If the school is not able to contact anyone, the “Permission For Emergency Care” form gives the school permission to act on behalf of the child’s safety and well being.

What if my child needs to be excused from P.E.?

In the event of illness or injury, you may excuse your child from P.E. for one day with a note or a call to the office. Please send a doctor’s note if your child needs to be excused more than one day.

What if my child forgets his/her breakfast or lunch money?

Charges are strongly discouraged. On rare occasions students forget or lose their money. In the event this happens they can charge the needed amount **FOR LUNCH ONLY**. We ask that charges be repaid the next day. **Charges are not allowed for breakfast.**

What if I want to come eat lunch with my child?

Parents are always welcome for lunch. If you are planning to join your child for lunch, please notify the school, if possible, so we can prepare. Please sign in at the office and get a visitor’s pass before proceeding to the cafeteria.
